

NOTTS BILLIARDS & SNOOKER ASSOCIATION – COMPETITION RULES

GENERAL

- A) The **HOME** player must contact his/her opponent at least 14 days before the closing date for the round and offer a minimum of 2 dates agreeable to the opponent for the match. In the event of agreement being impossible, contact must be made with to the competitions secretary explaining the situation.
- B) In each round it is the responsibility of the **WINNER** to inform the competitions secretary.

- C) If the competitions secretary has not received the result by the stipulated date, both players could be scratched.
- D) The competition shall be played in accordance with E.A.S.B rules.(Including the miss rule)
- E) The snooker matches, where players have tossed a coin for the opening break, players shall then break alternately without further tossing of the coin.
- F) Matches on neutral tables shall be arranged by the competitions secretary.
- G) Entry fees for the competitions shall be decided each year by the committee.
- H) In the event of a dispute the matter shall be resolved by the committee.
- I) Referees will be provided for all finals, and for the semi – finals if so requested. The referees decisions are final.

INDIVIDUAL SNOOKER CHAMPIONSHIP

- 1.
- A) Each round, up to and including the quarter finals, shall be played on the table of the first player drawn. The match shall be the best of five frames
- B) In each round up to and including the quarter finals, it is the responsibility of the **HOME PLAYER TO CONTACT HIS/HER OPPONENT** to make arrangements for the match.
- C) The semi – finals and the final shall consist of the best of seven frames played Bulwell Church Institute.

Junior Competition

- A) The competition shall be for those under the age of 18 years on the 31st December 2009
- B) Each round up to and including the quarter– finals shall be played on the table of the first drawn player. The match shall be the best of five frames.In each round up to and including the quarter finals, it is the responsibility of the **HOME PLAYER TO CONTACT HIS/HER OPPONENT** to make arrangements for the match.
- C) The semi-final and the final shall be the best of five frames and shall be played at Beeston Snooker Hall.
- D) Dependent on the number of entries and the discretion of the committee the Junior competition could be run on one day, played on a round robin basis. (Date TBA)
