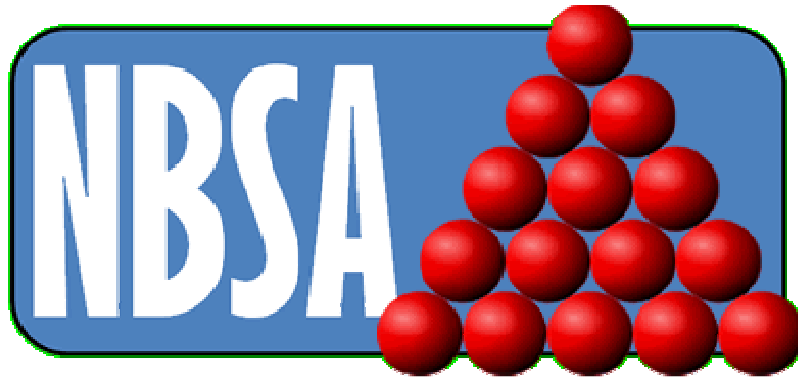


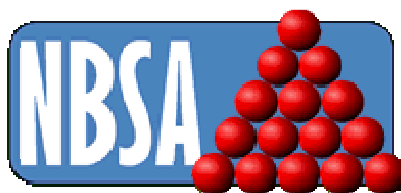

General terms and conditions

Who can enter?

Any amateur snooker player who plays at a club within the Nottinghamshire county boundary or resides at an address with an NG postcode. Main tour professionals cannot enter. The NBSA reserve the right to refuse entry.

Entry Fees

The entry fees for the 2011/12 season are as follows:

Notts Amateur Snooker Championship	£10
Notts Under 21 Snooker Championship	£10
All other competitions	£FREE**

** Entry is free if you have played at least once for a team competing in the Nazareth House Snooker League, Nottingham & Notts Institutes Association Snooker League, Bulwell & District Snooker League or Nottingham 6 Red Super League during 2010 or 2011. Otherwise an entry fee of £10 is payable and this will entitle you to enter as many of these other competitions as you wish.

Payment of entry fees

All entry fees must be paid in full by 30th September 2011. Fees can be paid either:

1. In cash to any member of the NSBA Committee.

Player details

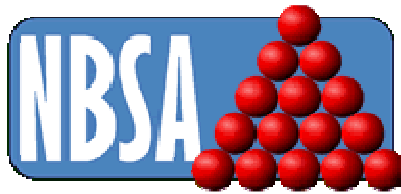
All entrants must provide their full name, a valid and current email address and a contact telephone number (preferably a mobile number). Entrants should be aware that their phone number will be published on the NBSA website. Any entrant who does not want their phone number published in this way must inform Steve Butler of this fact prior to the draw being published.

Rules

All competitions will be played in accordance with the official rules of snooker as published by the WPBSA and IBSF. The miss rule will be played unless both pairs of competitors elect not to play it.

NBSA Player Handicaps

All competitors will use their official NBSA player handicap during matches except for players in the Premier divisions who will play off scratch. The full list of NBSA official player handicaps can be found at www.nottinghamsnooker.com. Anyone wishing to enter this competition who does not hold an official NBSA handicap should request one from Steve Butler by telephone 07917 567295 or by email mail@nottinghamsnooker.com

Divisions

The size and make-up of divisions shall be set by Mike Langdon and will be dependent on the number of entries. Players will play each other once home and once away.

Match duration

All matches will be 4 frames in length and all 4 frames must be played. 2 points will be awarded for a win and 1 point for a draw.

Match venue

Matches will be played at any venue of the home player's choosing within the Nottinghamshire county boundary or with an NG postcode. It is the responsibility of the home player to ensure that a table is booked in advance of the match. The home player will pay table costs.

Arranging matches

Communication is key

All matches shall commence at 8pm on Thursday evenings. Should any player not be able to play his fixture at 8pm on the Thursday evening he should ensure he contacts his opponent no later than 8pm the day before (Wednesday) and both players should agree a new date to play the match asap.

Deadline date

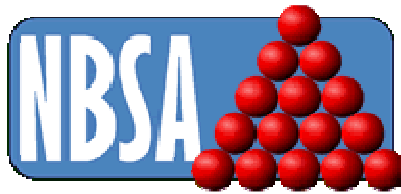
All matches will be scheduled for a Thursday evening at 2 weekly intervals. The deadline for the match to be played is the day before the following match. If a match result is not received within 13 days of the published match fixture date, the match will be awarded 4-0 to the away player.

League tables

League tables will be published on the NBSA website.

League positions will be determined in the following order:

- (i) Points gained
- (ii) Frame difference
- (iii) Results against tied player
- (iv) Five frame play-off match

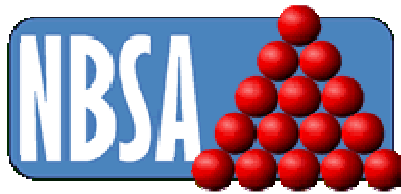

Restricted Entry

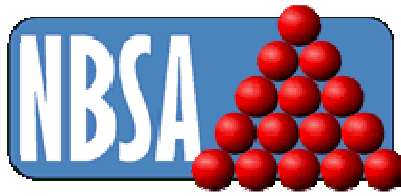
Entrants must be under 21 years old on 30th September 2011.
